


JBC Brotherhood Retreat 2014

1st Sunday: Last month, we were blessed with "The Gullah Lady" Sis. Sharon Cooper Murray, Guest speaker.






3rd Sunday: The children watched Charlie Brown's Thanksgiving movie. They enjoyed the movie with popcorn, various snacks, and drinks.



Davonte Brown




