
Joshua's Mission Statement

The Rollercoaster Ride of Life

Giving up mid-ride is not an option—It is foolish!



A depressed church member told his pastor, "I'm tired of trying. I have been down so long, I can't muster up the faith to believe God for deliverance anymore." The pastor said, "First, you can never justify quitting, because you have the Lord on your side. He won't quit on you, He promised He will never leave you nor forsake you so... do not be discouraged" (Deuteronomy 31:8).

Second, His Word says, 'If we are unfaithful, He remains faithful; for He cannot deny who He is' (2 Timothy 2:13). It's not just a matter of your faith, it's a matter of His faithfulness. When you can't seem to believe, instead of focusing on your faith in Him (or the lack of it), begin to focus on His faithfulness to you!" What great counsel for the rollercoaster ride of life. Now, let's add some more encouraging observations.

Know that God doesn't owe us an explanation so we shouldn't look for one, but He promises us an exit. He "will with the testing... make a way of escape, that you [might] be able to bear it" (1 Corinthians 10:13). Until the Lord gets you out of it, He will get you through it. Your part is to stay on the rollercoaster.

Almighty God is producing good in all of your circumstances (you just don't see it now). "And we know that all things work together for good to them... who are the called" (Romans 8:28). Father God puts pits and peaks together, and out comes your good. While He does so, the Son and Holy Spirit daily intercedes with Father God for you (Romans 8:34-39).

With all that's going on around us in our world today, you have so much good going for you! Open your eyes, fix your eyes on Christ Jesus... how can you fail at this point? Do not lose heart... Trust Him!
