
Joshua's Mission

Don't Stop Praying

If you want to quit praying because you've given up hope that God will answer your prayers, I want you to think on this truth:

"And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose."

Romans 8:28 NIV

We can trust God is working on our behalf for our good even if it doesn't feel like it. The truth is if it's not good, then God's not done. And if God's not done then neither are we. So let's hold on to God's truth over our feelings and wait patiently on Him.

What's Your Conscience Telling You?

Fire alarms have an internal switch triggered by a beam of light. As long as the light is received unbroken by the photosensitive receiver, the detector is quiet. But if smoke, moisture, or an insect obstructs the beam for even a split second, the alarm sounds.

Paying attention to that alarm can make the difference between life or death. And your conscience works on the same principle.



When sin obstructs the connection between you and God, your conscience signals that something is wrong. At that moment you should thank God for helping you to feel good about feeling bad. Only a fool would turn off the alarm or develop the ability to sleep through it. While certain things aren't "wrong" in themselves, they may be wrong for you because of the future God has in mind. That means there are things others can do that you can't.

So instead of being stubborn, rejoice in the knowledge that God has great things in store for you (if you obey Him). A French proverb says, "There is no pillow so soft as a clear conscience." Listening to your conscience will keep you from going the wrong way. However, if you decide to plow on regardless, your conscience will keep you from being at ease with your decision. And if you still press on, brace yourself for destruction!

Always ask yourself this question and you will make the right decision: "How will doing this affect my conscience and my relationship with God?" The Holy Bible says, "If your heart does not condemn you, you have confidence toward God" (1 John 3:21).

Driving along a long scenic route on the way to spend a weekend at a beautiful resort tucked away off the beaten path, the driver's GPS signal was interrupted as he approached a three-way split in the road. What should he do? He hadn't bothered to check over the details of the route, because the GPS had never failed him before. He began to panic and pulled the car over to ponder which road he should take. Navigating a two-directional crossroad is arduous enough but a three-way choice was enough to shake even the most experienced driver's confidence. Oh, call for help?! Well, he couldn't do that, because, what?...right, there was no signal transmitting to his phone! What would you do in a scenario like this one? Times like these make us discover that sometimes we have more faith in things man made than we do our Heavenly Father!

The absence of being able to assemble in fellowship at the church building sometimes causes professing Christians to find themselves seemingly experiencing a disconnect from God the Father. The enemy is having a field day. Children of God are letting down their weapons of vigilance and prayer, and it's just too easy for him to nudge Christians onto the Road of Fear and/or the Road of "Whatever!"

On the **Road of Fear**, feelings of isolation and powerlessness sometime make us feel God is so far away, and He isn't listening or responding to our prayers during this challenging time. The truth is, many of us have stepped a toe, at least, onto this road since last year until now. FEAR NOT!! God has not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind! **2 Tim 1:7** I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in Him will I trust. **Psalm 91:2**

Think the **Road of "Whatever!"** may be a better choice?! Hmm..let's see. On this road, the "It's My Right" mantra is in full effect! Like children without supervision, people's actions are displaying a "What Happens In Vegas Stays in Vegas!" attitude. Don't let the good times fool you! Be reminded that God is still the same place He's been since He created His universe. He still sees All, Knows All, and Reigns Supreme Over All!! Worshipping and Praising God will always be in natural order!

That in itself should light up the **Road of FAITH** with a huge arrow saying Child of God, this is the only way to the path that leads to Victory in Jesus.
